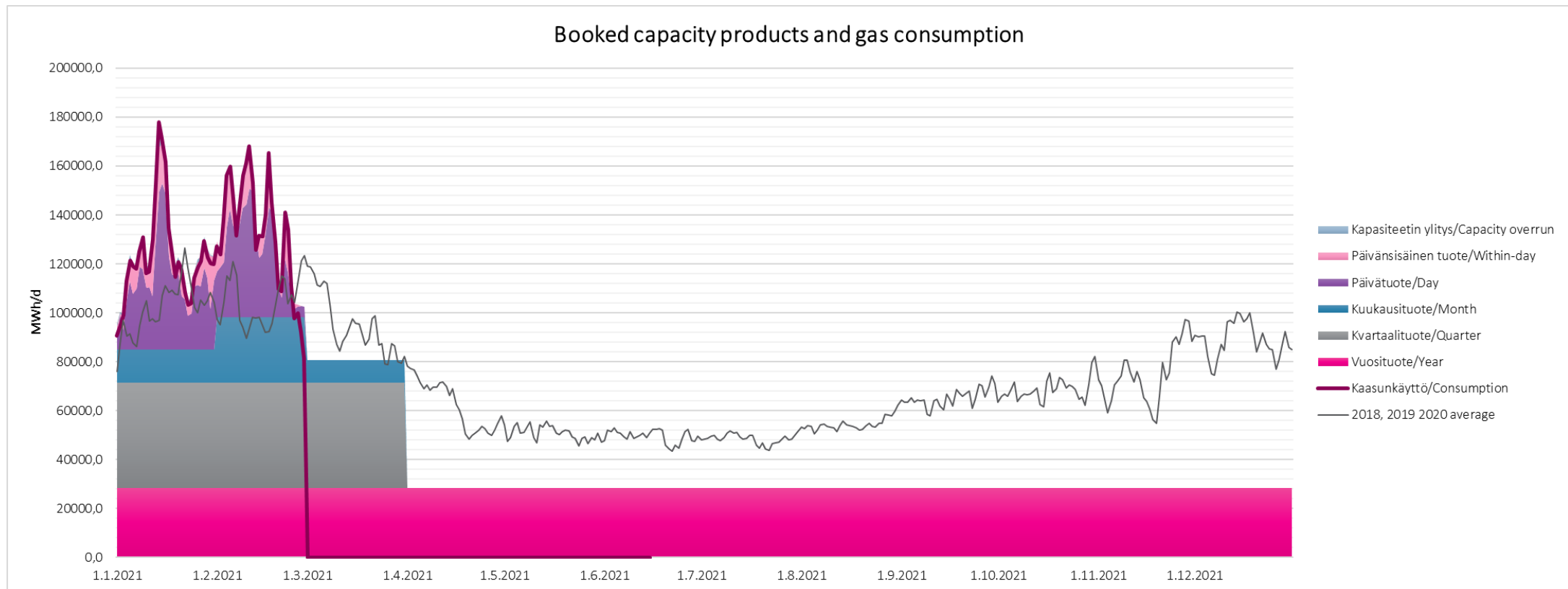

Booked exit zone capacity products and gas consumption

- 1) Gas consumption in January-February 2021 was app. 7,5 TWh
- 2) Gas consumption in January was app. 3,8 TWh (in January 2020 app. 2,6 TWh).
- 3) Gas consumption in February was app. 3,7 TWh (in February 2020 app. 2,4 TWh).
- 4) February was cold except the last days of the month which can be seen in gas consumption.

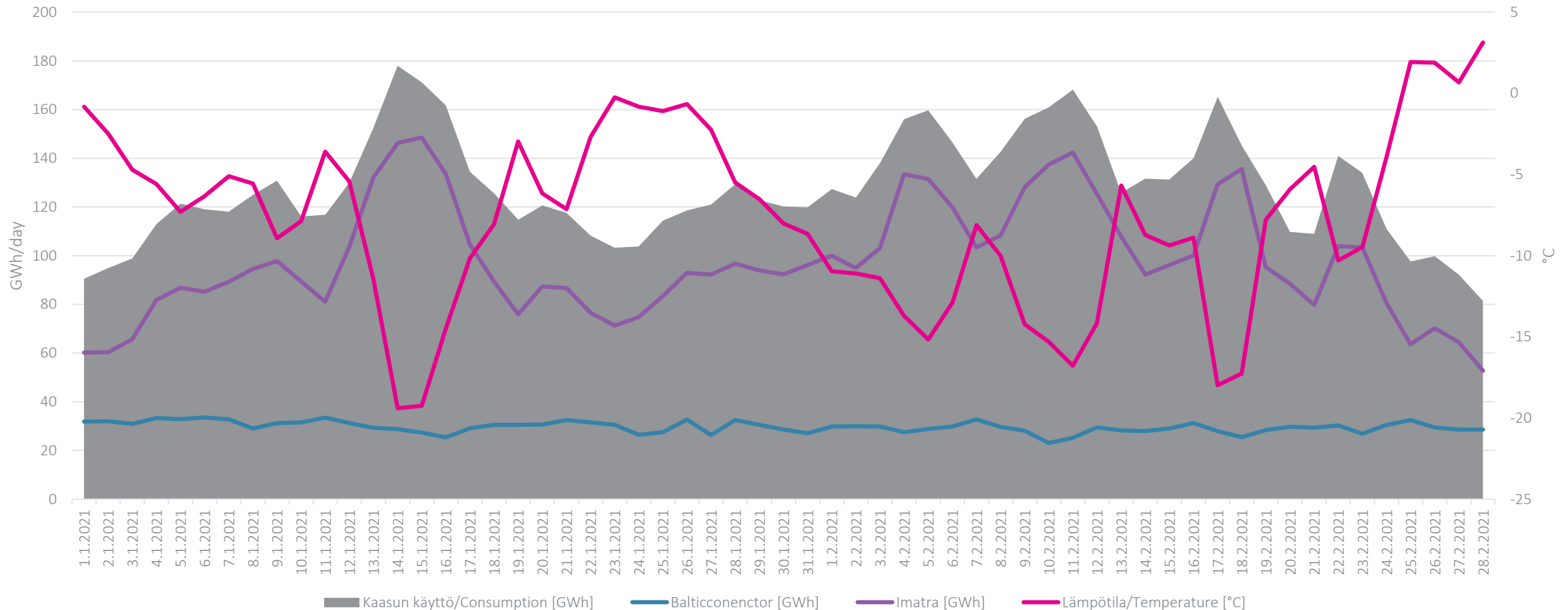
Exit zone consists of all end users connected to the Finnish gas system.



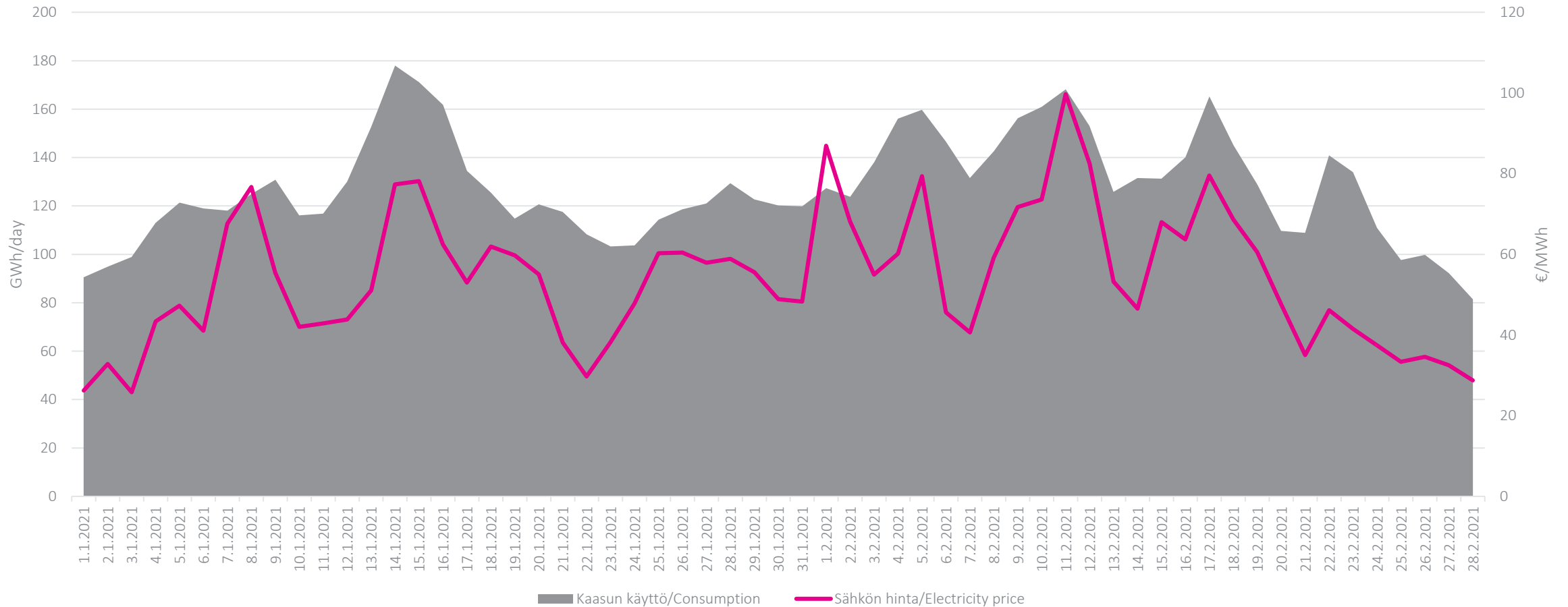
Imports and gas consumption vs. temperature

Gas consumption vs. electricity price

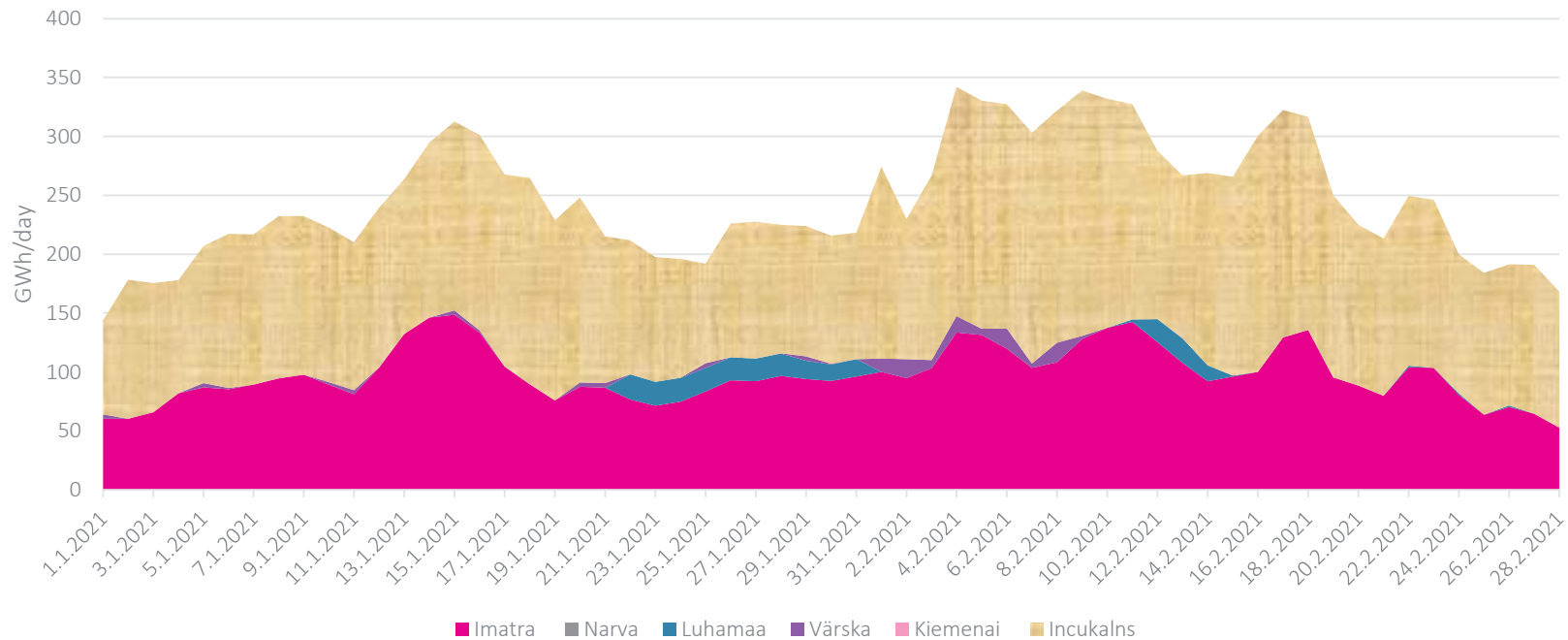


Electricity price: The average spot price in Finland.

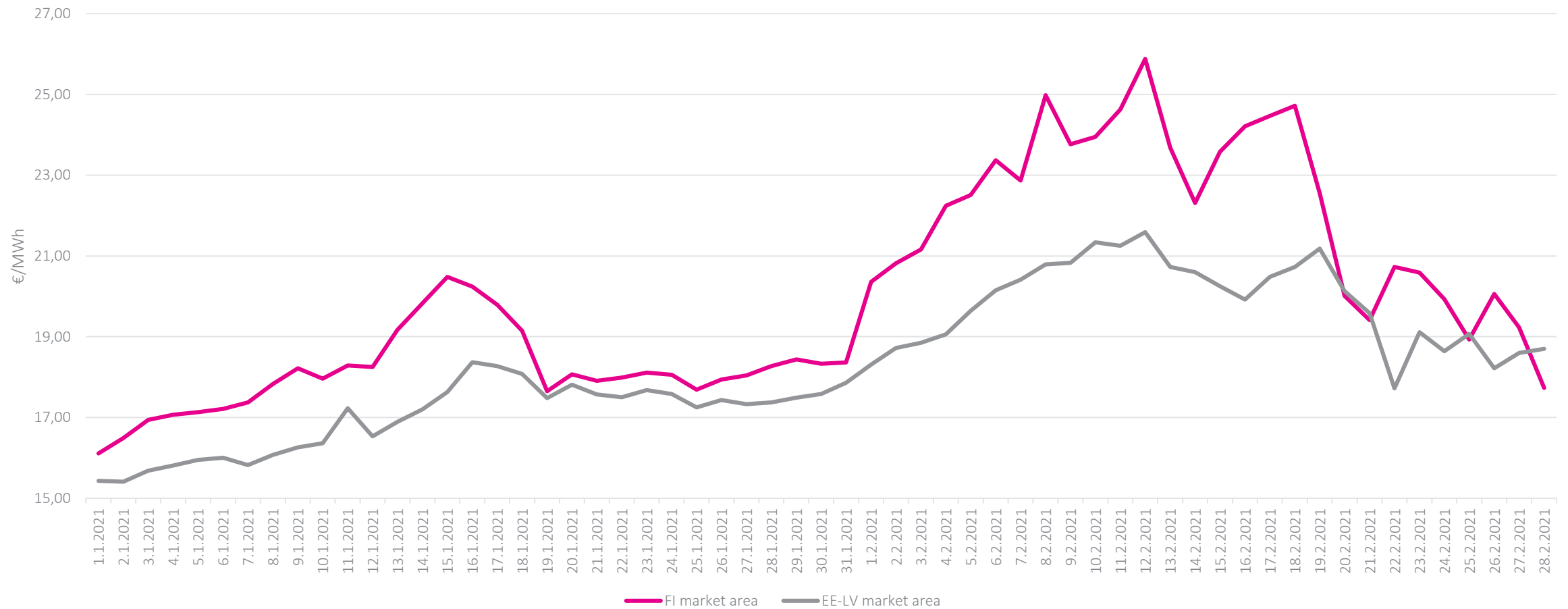
Common entry tariff zone “FINESTLAT”

- From the beginning of 2020, Finland, Estonia and Latvia established a common entry tariff zone where entry tariffs are harmonized, and entry-exit tariffs between the countries belonging to the common tariff zone have been removed.
