

Monthly neutrality charges 2021

The neutrality charge can be positive (+) or negative (-). If the neutrality charge is positive, it means Gasgrid charges the balance responsible party. If the neutrality charge is negative, Gasgrid compensates the balance responsible party.

In the following table, the unit prices of neutrality charges are presented:
