

Transmission system operator hereby notifies the market participants on the following clarifications to the application of the balancing service agreements:

- Transmission system operator guarantees that there is a sufficient quantity of daily capacity products available for Imatra entry point for any such day when the transmission system operator activates Call Orders for Imatra entry point.
- The transmission system operator emphasizes that the transmission system operator guarantees sufficient transmission capacity for balancing services agreements at Balticconnector interconnection point as stated in the Terms and Conditions for Balancing Services. If there is congestion in Balticconnector, the transmission system operator will prioritize Call Orders through Imatra entry point or domestic demand response. Hence balancing services agreements at Balticconnector entry or exit points do not reduce any capacity available to the market under congestion unless there is emergency.
- Balancing service contracts do not require that a shipper must separately and in advance reserve exactly the same quantity of capacity rights as the capacity of the balancing service agreement for the entire contract period to the point through which the shipper is contracted to supply gas when a Call Order is activated.
